Bachelor of Science in Psychology (Clinical Practice)

About this agreement:

Lackawanna College and Marywood University have agreed to a correlation of their curricula for students in the Associate in Science: Human Services at Lackawanna College who wish to complete the Bachelor of Science in Psychology (Clinical Practice) at Marywood University. Subject to the terms of this agreement, a student who satisfactorily completes the requirements of the AS degree at Lackawanna with a 2.5 grade point average or above, will be granted admission to Marywood University and will have his/her credits earned with a grade of 'C' or better, accepted for transfer based on the articulation agreement equivalency. However, the following terms and conditions shall apply:

- 1) A minimum of 120 credits are required for an undergraduate degree in Psychology (Clinical Practice) at Marywood University.
- 2) Transfer students must complete a minimum of 42 credits at Marywood.
- 3) Students must maintain a 3.3 GPA in their major, and a 2.0 overall GPA in order to graduate from Marywood.
- 4) This agreement is to be used as a guide only. Marywood University cannot guarantee that the needed courses will be offered in a given semester.
- 5) The University estimates that a student can earn her/his BS in Psychology (Clinical Practice) in two years (minimum of four semesters) provided s/he follows the articulation agreement.
- 6) The student must meet all deadline dates for application to the University, payment of fees, and any other deadlines as they apply to all new students at Marywood.
- 7) The student shall choose the recommended elective courses and course sequences as shown on the articulation agreement.
- 8) The student must not attend another institution of higher education between graduating from Lackawanna College and enrolling at Marywood University.

If any of the above terms and conditions are not met, Marywood University shall determine the appropriate number of transfer credits on an individual basis.

Students who wish to transfer to Marywood University prior to obtaining their Associate's degree from Lackawanna College must submit their official transcript for a course-by-course evaluation. They must also complete the standard core curriculum at Marywood University.

This agreement may be terminated at any time by either Marywood University or Lackawanna College via a written notice thirty days in advance of the effective date of termination. It is understood that any termination will not apply to students who have already started the Associate Degree program in Human Services Studies at Lackawanna College or the Bachelor of Science program in Psychology (Clinical Practice) at Marywood University.

Student must submit a final copy of official transcript after Associate's Degree has been conferred. Student will follow standard core until proof of degree is received. 120 credits are required for completion of the Bachelor's Degree. Student must earn a minimum of 42 credits at Marywood University; at least one-half of the credits required for a major must also be earned at Marywood.

Requirements to be completed in 4 semesters at Marywood University:

Core:

This articulation agreement includes an abbreviated core curriculum. Student must complete 18 credits of core at Marywood. Student will be given a choice of core tracks, based on area of interest. All 18 credits must be completed at Marywood. Courses taken in track cannot be duplicated from general education courses completed at Lackawanna College.
